M.Tech / MSR Stipend Revision

Evidence from 282 Public Responses

From

Aarunya Issues — Issue #003

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1. Executive Summary

Aarunya Issues conducted a public survey to understand the views of students, researchers, alumni and other members of the technical-education community on the current GATE-qualified M.Tech stipend of ₹12,400 per month and the proposal to revise it to ₹20,000 per month.

A total of 282 responses were received and analysed.

The key findings are clear:

- 280 of 282 respondents (99.3%) support increasing the stipend to ₹20,000 per month.
- 2 respondents (0.7%) do not support the proposed increase.
- 237 respondents (84.0%) are M.Tech/MSR students, the group directly affected by the stipend policy.
- 32 respondents (11.3%) are B.Tech students.
- 8 respondents (2.8%) are alumni.
- 2 respondents (0.7%) are PhD scholars.
- 3 respondents (1.1%) selected “Other.”
- 251 of 282 respondents (89.0%) said they would be willing to help with the issue by sharing it, volunteering, or spreading awareness.
- Responses were received from 26 States and Union Territories.
- Respondents identified approximately 90 distinct institutions after normalising obvious spelling and naming variations.
- Approximately 74% of responses came from IITs.

The survey also included an optional written-response field. 76 respondents entered text, of which 74 provided substantive written comments.

The most recurring concerns included:

- lack of guaranteed hostel accommodation;
- high private accommodation costs, particularly in Delhi;
- the stipend remaining unchanged since 2015 despite increasing living and academic expenses;
- comparison with the 2023 revision of PhD fellowship rates;
- financial dependence on families;
- and requests for HRA or accommodation support.

This report presents the survey evidence, the concerns raised by respondents, the policy background and the case for revising the stipend.

2. Why We Conducted This Survey

The GATE-qualified M.Tech stipend currently stands at ₹12,400 per month.

The stipend was last revised in February 2015, when it was increased from ₹8,000 to ₹12,400.

More than a decade has passed since that revision.

During this period, students have experienced substantial increases in accommodation, food, transportation, education and other living expenses.

Before taking the issue forward as a formal representation, Aarunya Issues decided to ask students and members of the wider technical-education community a simple question:

Do you support increasing the GATE M.Tech stipend to ₹20,000 per month?

The purpose of the survey was to document the level of support, understand who is affected, identify the concerns students are facing and collect evidence that can be presented to the relevant authorities.

3. Who Responded?

The survey received 282 responses.

The majority of respondents were directly affected by the stipend policy.

M.Tech/MSR students therefore account for 84.0% of all respondents.

This is important because the people directly affected by the stipend policy form the largest group participating in the survey.

4. Responses from Across India

The survey received responses from 26 States and Union Territories.

The responses cover institutions and participants from different parts of India.

The two largest contributors were Uttar Pradesh and Delhi, which together accounted for approximately 43% of responses. This reflects the concentration of responses from institutions including IIT Kanpur and IIT Delhi and the way the campaign was initially circulated.

The survey should not be interpreted as a statistically representative national sample of all M.Tech students.

It is a voluntary public survey, and participation depended on how the campaign reached students in different institutions and States.

Nevertheless, the geographic spread demonstrates that the issue has attracted responses well beyond a single campus.

5. Institutional Representation

Respondents identified approximately 90 distinct institutions, after obvious spelling and naming variants were normalised.

The responses included students and members associated with:

- IITs
- NITs
- IIITs
- universities
- engineering colleges
- other technical institutions

Approximately 74% of responses came from IITs, while the remaining responses came from NITs, IIITs and other institutions.

The institutional distribution reflects the campaign's outreach pattern and should not be interpreted as the national institutional distribution of M.Tech students.

6. The Main Question

Respondents were asked:

“Do you support increasing the GATE M.Tech stipend to ₹20,000 per month?”

The response was:

280 YES

99.3% SUPPORT

Only:

2 respondents NO

0.7% OPPOSE

Among the respondents to this voluntary survey, support for the proposed revision was therefore overwhelmingly high.

This figure represents the people who participated in this survey. It is not a claim that 99.3% of all M.Tech students in India support the proposal.

7. Support Across Respondent Groups

Support was not limited to M.Tech/MSR students.

The survey received support from respondents across the different categories included in the form.

Both opposing responses came from M.Tech/MSR respondents.

All B.Tech students, alumni, PhD scholars and respondents in the “Other” category who answered the support question supported the proposed revision.

This indicates that the issue is also viewed as relevant by people beyond the group currently receiving the stipend.

8. Will People Help Take the Issue Forward?

Respondents were separately asked:

“Would you be willing to help with this issue — share it, volunteer, or spread the word?”

251 of 282 respondents said YES.

That represents:

89.0%

willing to help

This result indicates that a large majority of respondents expressed willingness to do more than simply record their opinion.

The survey question combined sharing, volunteering and spreading awareness into one response. Therefore, this report does not claim that 89.0% specifically volunteered for a particular form of action.

9. What Students Said

The survey included an optional question:

“Anything you would like to add?”

A total of 76 respondents entered text.

After excluding entries that contained no substantive comment, such as “no”, “nil”, “-” or similar responses, 74 substantive comments remained for qualitative analysis.

These responses were read individually and grouped into recurring themes.

9.1 Hostel and Accommodation

One of the strongest recurring concerns was the availability and cost of accommodation.

Respondents highlighted situations in which M.Tech students do not receive guaranteed hostel accommodation and therefore have to depend on private accommodation.

Several respondents specifically referred to the cost of rent in Delhi.

The concern is straightforward:

When accommodation itself consumes a large portion of the monthly stipend, very little remains for food, transportation, academic expenses or emergencies.

Some respondents specifically called for guaranteed hostel accommodation for M.Tech students.

9.2 Rising Costs and a Stagnant Stipend

Respondents repeatedly compared today's expenses with the stipend fixed in 2015.

Comments referred to increases in:

- tuition and semester fees;
- accommodation;
- food and mess expenses;
- transportation;
- daily living costs;
- academic and research-related expenses.

The central concern was that the stipend has remained unchanged while the costs students have to meet have not.

Some respondents argued that a present-day stipend of approximately ₹20,000–₹25,000 would be more realistic.

9.3 Comparison with PhD Fellowships

Several respondents compared the M.Tech stipend with the revision of Junior Research Fellowship and Senior Research Fellowship rates in 2023.

The JRF and SRF rates were revised to ₹37,000 and ₹42,000 per month respectively under the relevant Ministry of Finance order.

Respondents questioned why the M.Tech stipend remained at ₹12,400 while other research-related fellowship rates were revised.

The survey does not argue that the two schemes are identical. Rather, the comparison reflects a concern raised directly by respondents about the relative level of financial support available to postgraduate researchers.

9.4 Financial Dependence on Family

Several respondents described continued financial dependence on their families while pursuing postgraduate education.

For some students, the stipend is expected to cover essential living expenses while they simultaneously manage coursework, projects and research.

Respondents argued that inadequate financial support can make postgraduate education difficult for students who do not have strong financial backing from their families.

9.5 HRA and Accommodation Support

Multiple respondents specifically requested House Rent Allowance (HRA) or some form of accommodation support.

This concern was particularly relevant to students who are unable to obtain institutional hostel accommodation.

The survey therefore raises two related policy questions:

Should the base stipend be revised?

and

Should students without access to institutional accommodation receive appropriate additional support?

9.6 Research and Career Choices

Some respondents argued that the financial gap between postgraduate study and immediate employment can influence students' decisions about pursuing M.Tech and research.

A capable B.Tech graduate may have the option of entering industry immediately.

If pursuing postgraduate education means accepting a stipend that does not adequately cover basic living costs, financial considerations can become an additional barrier to choosing research-oriented education.

10. Policy Background

The GATE-qualified M.Tech stipend was last revised to:

₹12,400 per month

with effect from 1 February 2015, up from ₹8,000.

The applicable AICTE Post Graduate Scholarship Guidelines referenced by Aarunya Issues continue to specify ₹12,400 per month for eligible GATE-qualified postgraduate students, subject to the scheme's conditions.

The stipend has therefore remained at the same nominal amount for more than a decade.

Separately, AICTE has been reported to have proposed a 50% increase in the stipend, from ₹12,400 to approximately ₹18,600 per month. This proposal has not been implemented, and Aarunya Issues requests AICTE to officially confirm its current status and proposed amount.

In 2023, Junior Research Fellowship and Senior Research Fellowship rates were revised to ₹37,000 and ₹42,000 per month respectively under the relevant Ministry of Finance order.

The M.Tech stipend was not revised as part of that 2023 JRF/SRF revision.

11. Why ₹20,000?

The ₹20,000 figure is the policy demand of Aarunya Issues.

It is not an amount currently approved by AICTE.

The demand is based partly on the purchasing power of the stipend when it was last revised.

Using the cumulative India CPI inflation series cited by Aarunya Issues, ₹12,400 in February 2015 corresponds to approximately ₹20,320 in 2026 terms.

On this basis, ₹20,000 is intended as a simple, rounded figure that broadly restores the purchasing power of the 2015 stipend.

In simple terms:

₹12,400 in 2015 $\approx$ ₹20,320 in 2026 terms

Therefore:

Our demand: ₹20,000/month

This calculation is an analysis based on CPI data. It is not an official Government of India inflation-adjustment figure.

12. What We Are Asking For

Based on the survey responses and the policy evidence, Aarunya Issues requests:

1. Revise the GATE M.Tech stipend to ₹20,000 per month.

This is our primary demand.

2. Implement the reported AICTE proposal at minimum.

If ₹20,000 cannot be implemented immediately, we request that the reported AICTE proposal to increase the stipend to approximately ₹18,600 per month be implemented without further delay, subject to AICTE confirming its current status.

3. Introduce periodic stipend revision.

A stipend should not remain unchanged for another decade.

We propose a transparent review mechanism, for example, at least once every three years, linked to a published inflation indicator such as CPI.

4. Publish the status of the pending proposal.

Students should be able to know:

- whether a revision proposal exists;
- its exact proposed amount;
- its current stage;
- the authority responsible for the decision;
- and the expected timeline, where available.

5. Consider accommodation/HRA support.

For eligible postgraduate scholars who cannot obtain institutional hostel accommodation, appropriate accommodation or HRA support should be considered within the applicable policy and budget framework.

13. What This Survey Does — and Does Not — Establish

This survey establishes the views of the 282 people who responded.

It demonstrates:

- very high support among respondents for the proposed stipend revision;
- strong participation from directly affected M.Tech/MSR students;
- responses from multiple States and Union Territories;
- representation from a large number of institutions;
- substantial willingness among respondents to help take the issue forward;
- and recurring concerns regarding accommodation, living costs and financial pressure.

However, the survey does not claim to represent every M.Tech student in India.

It was a voluntary, self-selected public survey distributed through campaign networks.

We believe this distinction is important.

Transparency about the limits of our data is part of the evidence we are presenting.

14. Methodology

Survey type

Voluntary online public-response survey.

Sample

282 responses.

Respondent groups

M.Tech/MSR students, B.Tech students, PhD scholars, alumni and other members of the technical-education community.

Distribution

The survey was shared through the Aarunya Issues website, social-media channels and direct outreach to student networks.

Sampling method

Convenience/self-selected sampling.

Respondents chose to participate after encountering the campaign.

Geographic coverage

26 States and Union Territories.

Institutional coverage

Approximately 90 distinct institutions after normalising obvious naming and spelling variations.

Written responses

76 respondents entered text in the optional comment field.

74 comments were considered substantive after excluding blank or non-substantive entries.

Data validation

The available survey data does not specify whether duplicate-response controls or independent identity verification were performed.

Accordingly, this report does not claim independent verification of unique respondents.

15. Limitations

This survey has several limitations that should be clearly understood.

Self-selection

The survey used voluntary participation rather than random sampling.

Outreach concentration

Early campaign outreach was concentrated around IIT Delhi and IIT Kanpur, which is reflected in the institutional distribution.

Institutional classification

Institution names were entered as free text. Obvious spelling and naming variants were normalised, but institutional classification was not based on an official national institutional database.

No independent identity verification

The available survey information does not establish whether every submission represents a separately verified individual.

Combined willingness question

The willingness question combined sharing, volunteering and spreading awareness. The survey therefore cannot determine how many respondents would choose each individual form of participation.

These limitations do not invalidate the survey. They define what conclusions can responsibly be drawn from it.

16. Key Findings

282

The overall message from the respondents is consistent:

The current ₹12,400 stipend is widely viewed by respondents as inadequate for present-day postgraduate living and study costs, and there is overwhelming support among survey participants for its revision.

17. Recommendations

Based on the survey evidence and policy background, Aarunya Issues recommends:

Immediate

Increase the GATE M.Tech stipend to ₹20,000 per month.

Interim

If the full revision cannot be implemented immediately, implement the reported AICTE proposal of approximately ₹18,600 per month, subject to confirmation of its current status.

Long-term

Establish a transparent periodic revision mechanism, preferably with a review at least every three years.

Transparency

Publish the status, proposed amount and decision timeline of any pending stipend revision.

Accommodation

Consider appropriate HRA or accommodation support for eligible students who cannot obtain institutional hostel accommodation.

18. What Happens Next?

This survey is not the end of the issue.

It is the evidence-gathering stage.

Aarunya Issues will now take the findings forward through a formal representation to the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

The representation will request:

- revision of the stipend to ₹20,000 per month;
- implementation of the reported ₹18,600 proposal at minimum, if applicable;
- periodic future revision;
- transparency regarding the current status of the proposal; and
- consideration of accommodation/HRA support.

We will publish the representation and track the response publicly.

If AICTE responds, the response will be published.

If there is no response, that will also be recorded publicly.

The objective is simple:

Every step of this issue should be visible to the students who supported it.

19. Our Commitment

Aarunya Issues will maintain a public record of:

- the survey;
- the evidence;
- the representation submitted;
- the response received;
- follow-up communications;
- and the eventual outcome.

We will not publish individual respondents' personal information.

We will publish aggregate numbers and evidence relevant to the public discussion.

We will also correct factual errors if credible evidence demonstrates that something we published is incorrect.

20. Conclusion

The question presented to respondents was simple:

Should the GATE M.Tech stipend be increased from ₹12,400 to ₹20,000 per month?

Among the 282 people who responded:

280 said YES.

That is 99.3% of respondents.

The respondents included M.Tech/MSR students, B.Tech students, PhD scholars, alumni and others from 26 States and Union Territories and approximately 90 institutions.

Their written responses point repeatedly to the same practical concerns: accommodation shortages, rent, rising living and academic costs, financial dependence on families and the long period since the stipend was last revised.

This survey does not claim to speak for every M.Tech student in India.

It does something more specific:

It records, transparently and publicly, what 282 people told us.

The evidence now exists.

The next question is what happens with it.

₹12,400 was fixed in 2015.

The cost of living did not remain fixed.

It is time to review the GATE M.Tech stipend.

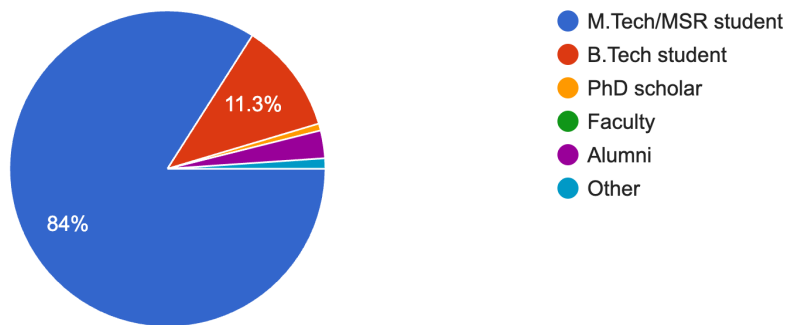

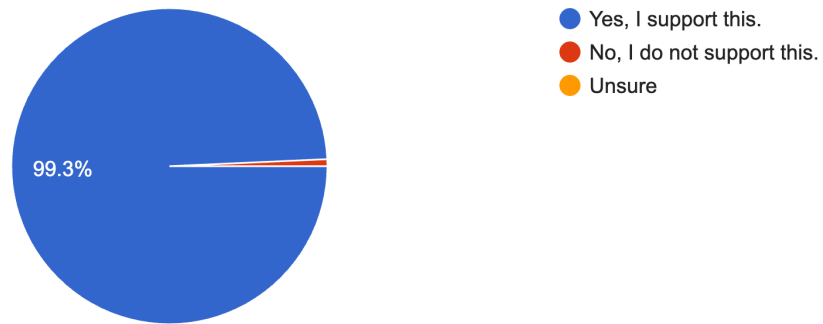

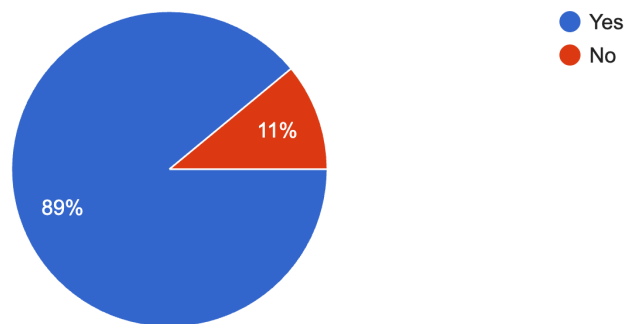
Do you support increasing the GATE M.Tech stipend to ₹20,000 per month?
